A LETTER FROM PASTOR CLAY

DEAR GRACE PLACE FAMILY,

Throughout scripture there are many reminders to remember what the Lord has done. The Psalmist wrote, “I will remember the deeds of the Lord Remember the wonders he has done, his miracles He has caused his wonders to be remembered; the Lord is gracious and compassionate” Psalm 77:11; 105:5; 111:4.

Why does God want us to remember what he has done? Do you think that’s because God loves reminiscing about the “good old days?” Neither do I. His reminder to remember his grace in the past is an encouragement to trust him for what he plans in the future. Past grace points toward future grace. This annual report is a glance at our past that serves several purposes.

First, there is an element of celebration. God has been abundantly faithful. Just look at all that he has done in our midst. Throughout last year, we saw dozens new small groups, we baptized more than 60 new Christ followers, we served hundreds of folks in need, and helped plant a new church!

Second, this annual report provides a measure of accountability from your leadership and fellow church members. The mission of the Grace Place isn’t carried forward by a handful of people with the anointing of God. It’s carried forward by every person who is pursuing the leadership of the Spirit.

Third, this is a challenge for us to remain faithful. One of my prayers for Grace Place has been that as God makes us bigger, we would never lose the spirit and focus we had at our beginning that our primary mission is bringing other people to Jesus. What will God do now if we keep making ourselves available to him? Our God is not just a God of the past. He’s a God of the present and of the future. I firmly believe that the best is yet to come!

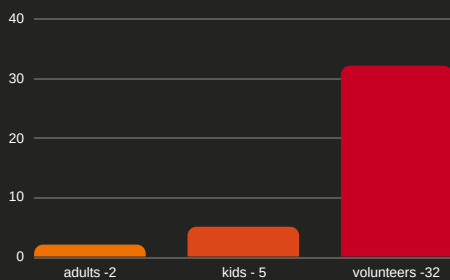

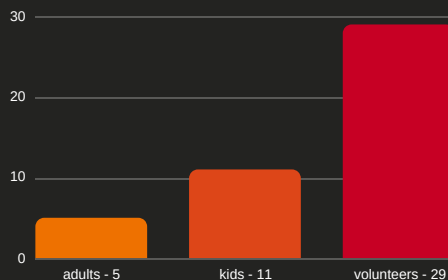
Angel House 2018 Total Impact

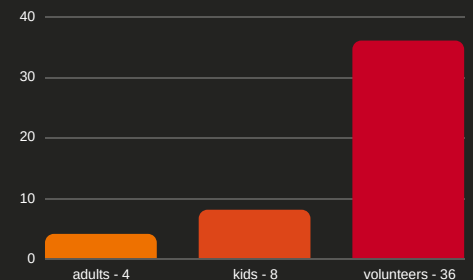

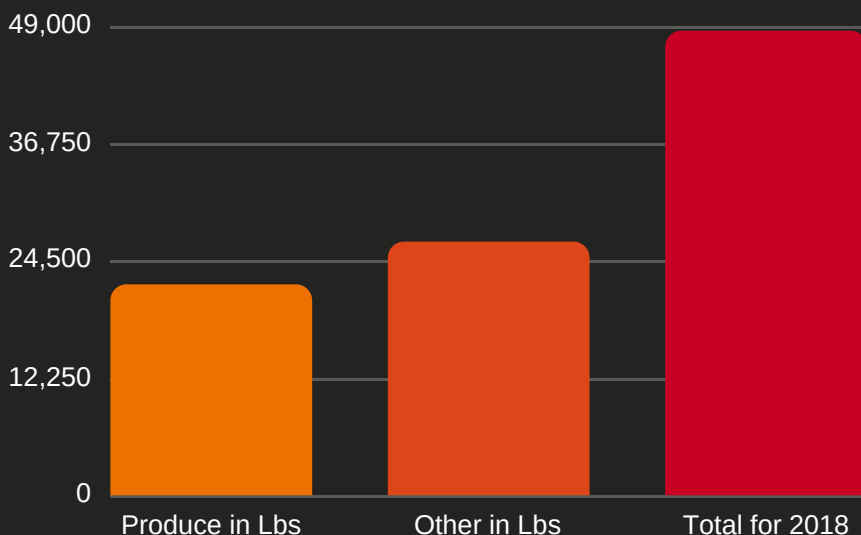

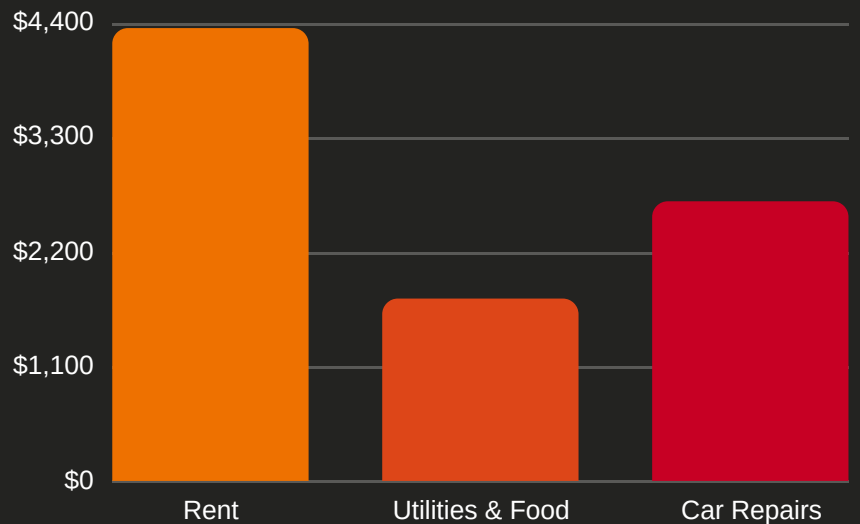

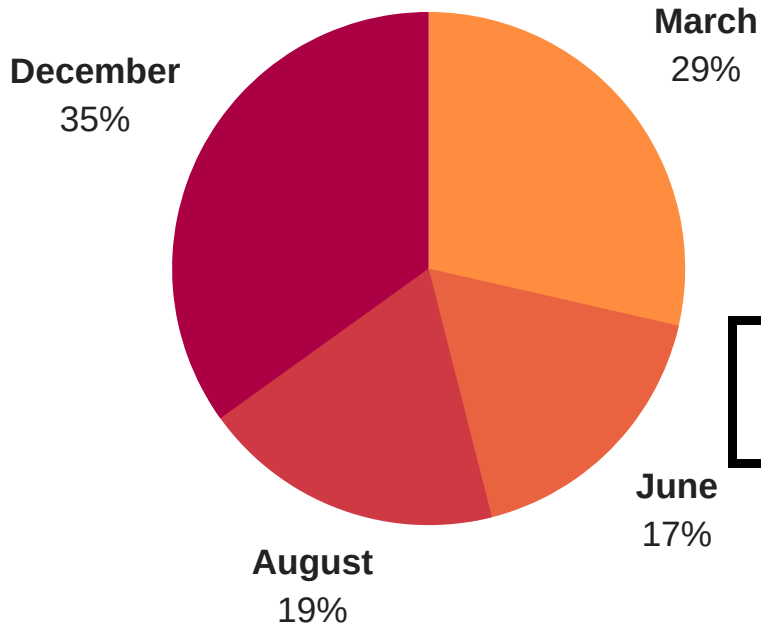
